*Brian McNabb Announces Candidacy for

(Baton Rouge - LA) Brian McNabb is announcing today his intention to be a candidate for Louisiana State Representative from District 69.

Previously, Brian McNabb was Political Director of the Republican Party of Louisiana. Following his many successes in Louisiana, McNabb received an appointment in the Administration of George W. Bush where he served as a top aide at the United States Environmental Protection Agency in Washington, D.C. As Special Assistant and Personal Aide to Stephen L. Johnson, the 11th Administrator of the EPA and a member of the President’s Cabinet, McNabb directed the day-to-day operations of the Administrator’s office, and regularly communicated with White House officials, members of Congress, Governors and other state and local officials.
